AGREEMENT BETWEEN USER AND CORLINC.COM

Corlinc provides this Privacy Policy for the www.corlinc.com website (the "Site"), which is comprised of various web pages operated by Corlinc ("Corlinc"). At Corlinc, we are serious about your privacy. This Privacy Policy is designed to help you understand what information we collect through our website and services (the "Site"), how we may use and disclose such information, and to help you make informed decisions when using the (the "Site"). By using or accessing (the "Site"), you consent to the practices described in this Privacy Policy. This document is incorporated as a part of our Website Terms of Use.

COLLECTION AND USE OF YOUR INFORMATION

Our primary goal in collecting your information is to improve our site, services, features and content, administrate your Subscription and Membership, and create an ever-improving user experience.

The information we collect may be "personally identifiable" (meaning it can be used to specifically identify you as a unique person) or "non-personally identifiable" (meaning it can't be used to specifically identify you). We use both types of information, and combinations of both types, as described below. We may use or store information wherever Corlinc does business, including countries outside your own.

When you register with Corlinc and submit personal information to create an account or profile, other users may see your name or other provided information, which may include (but is not limited to): your photo, location, email address, or any personal information provided in your Profile. When you set up a Community and link your social media accounts, you are giving us permission to access your information in other social media sites and/or services (such as Facebook, Twitter, Google+) to aggregate those feeds into your Community. The information we may obtain from those services is dependent upon your settings in your account profile with them and/or their privacy policies. Information that you consider to be sensitive should be omitted from your Profile.

Corlinc aggregates information from third party sites to enrich your Community. Nearly all websites or internet-based devices collect and record information. We may also disclose non-identifying information and log data with third parties for analytics, industry analysis, demographic profiling and other purposes. Your personal information is important to us and it will not be shared, except as noted above.

Google

Google Analytics Demographics and Interest Reporting has been integrated into our website to gather certain demographics and interest's information about our users. This information may include your gender, age, interests and/or online behavior.

Google's advertising requirements can be summed up by Google's Advertising Principles. They are put in place to provide a positive experience for users.

OTHER INFORMATION:

As a member of Corlinc and/or a member of any Corlinc Community, you may follow topics of interest contained either in the Communities or within the Forums and Blogs. You may also create online relationships, create searches, build an eCommerce store, aggregate social media feeds, set up events, upload documents and/or media, interact with multiple organizations, designate strategic partnerships, and transmit information through multiple available channels. This information is collected to determine the preferences of our Members and facilitate personalization for future use. Third parties do not have access to the Platform to collect personally identifiable information regarding a user's online activities over time and across different websites.

We may collect data regarding the type of device you use to access our website. This information helps us provide a better experience to our Members. The information we collect may include: the type of device, the operating system, device settings or identifiers for a device crash. You may check with the manufacturer of your device or software to learn more about the information your device transmits. We may also use third party services such as Google Analytics Demographics and Interest Reporting to obtain information regarding the use of our Platform.

ADDITIONAL FORMS OF DATA COLLECTION: COOKIES/PIXELS

Like most websites, mobile applications or other Internet applications, we (or our third-party service providers) may use "cookies" or "pixels" to improve your experience on our site. A cookie is a small data file that we transfer to your computer or mobile device's hard disk for record-keeping purposes. There are two types of cookies that are utilized:

A PERSISTENT COOKIE.

This cookie is utilized to save your login information for future logins to the Site. (This stores your login information but not your password).

SESSION COOKIE.

This allows us to confirm that users are logged in (they last until you close your browser) and to enable certain features of the Site, to better understand how you interact with the Site and to monitor web traffic routing on the Site. Unlike persistent cookies, session cookies are deleted from your computer when you log off from the Site and Service and then close your browser. Third party advertisers on the Site may also place or read cookies on your browser. You can instruct your browser, by changing its options, to stop accepting cookies or to prompt you before accepting a cookie from the websites you visit. If you do not accept cookies, however, you may not be able to use all portions of the Site or all functionality of the Service.

DISABLE COOKIES:

If you turn cookies off it will turn off some of the features of the site.

THIRD-PARTY DISCLOSURE

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties your Personally Identifiable Information unless we provide users with notice. This does not include website hosting partners and other parties who assist us in operating our website, conducting our business, or serving our users, so long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential. We may also release information when it's release is appropriate to comply with the law, enforce our site policies, or protect ours or others' rights, property or safety.

However, non-personally identifiable visitor information may be provided to other parties for marketing, advertising, or other uses.

THIRD-PARTY LINKS

Occasionally, at our discretion, we may include or offer third-party products or services on our website. These third-party sites have separate and independent privacy policies. We, therefore, have no responsibility or liability for the content and activities of these linked sites. Nonetheless, we seek to protect the integrity of our site and welcome any feedback about these sites.

HOW WE USE COLLECTED INFORMATION

The information you provide may be used by Corlinc in the following ways:

- We may collect information that furthers our efforts to make your Member experience a better one with more pertinent features and content. We may also suggest content or show ads to you based upon Community types or industries you have either browsed, been a guest in, or registered for Subscription or Membership with.
- Your Collected Information will also be used to better facilitate relationship networking, enhance content features for the Forums and Blogs, further customize eCommerce store features, and guide long-term development of the Corlinc platform. This may include allowing Corlinc members to search for your Community or your profile using either your name, your Community name, or your email address.
- We may send you related Community updates, marketing emails, newsletters, information, or general support that matches your interest profile.

We may use the information we collect from you when you register, make a purchase, sign up for our newsletter, respond to a survey or marketing communication, surf the website, or use certain other site features in the following ways:

Specifically, we may use third parties to facilitate our service, to provide the service on our behalf, to perform site-related services, processing payments for products or services, providing search results, advertisements or links (including sponsored links). In direct correlation to these offerings and business operations, these third-party service providers may have access to your personally identifiable information only to perform these tasks on our behalf and are obligated not to disclose or use it for any other purpose.
- Corlinc may sell, transfer, or otherwise share some assets, including your personal information, in the event of a merger, acquisition, sale, bankruptcy or reorganization of the company.

Our Site contains links to other websites. SECURITY

We will make any legally required disclosures of any breach of the security, confidentiality, or integrity of your unencrypted electronically stored "personal data" (as defined in applicable state statutes on security breach notification) to you via email or conspicuous posting on this Site in the most expedient

time possible and without unreasonable delay, insofar as consistent with (i) the legitimate needs of law enforcement or (ii) any measures necessary to determine the scope of the breach and restore the reasonable integrity of the data system.

IF AT ANY TIME YOU WOULD LIKE TO UNSUBSCRIBE FROM RECEIVING FUTURE EMAILS, OR OUR SERVICES, Follow the instructions at the bottom of each email, and we will promptly remove you from ALL correspondence.

- Cancel and delete your account via the Account page.

HOW DO WE PROTECT YOUR INFORMATION?

- We do not use vulnerability scanning and/or scanning to PCI standards.
- An external PCI compliant payment gateway handles all CC transactions.
- We use regular Malware Scanning.
- We use an SSL

Your personal information is contained behind secured networks and is only accessible by a limited number of persons who have special access rights to such systems and are required to keep the information confidential. In addition, all sensitive/credit information you supply is encrypted via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology.

We implement a variety of security measures when a user enters, submits, or accesses their information to maintain the safety of your personal information.

All transactions are processed through a gateway provider and are not stored or processed on our servers.

INTERNATIONAL SITES

Your information may be transferred to - and maintained on - computers located outside of your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the privacy laws may not be as protective as those in your jurisdiction. If you are located outside the United States and choose to provide information to us, Corlinc transfers Personal Information to the United States and processes it there. Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by your submission of such information represents your agreement to that transfer.

CALIFORNIA ONLINE PRIVACY PROTECTION ACT

CalOPPA is the first state law in the nation to require commercial websites and online services to post a privacy policy. COPPA (CHILDREN ONLINE PRIVACY PROTECTION ACT)

When it comes to the collection of personal information from children under the age of 13 years old, the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) puts parents in control. The Federal Trade Commission, United States' consumer protection agency, enforces the COPPA Rule, which spells out what operators of websites and online services must do to protect children's privacy and safety online.

We do not specifically market to children under the age of 13 years old.

FAIR INFORMATION PRACTICES

The Fair Information Practices Principles form the backbone of privacy law in the United States and the concepts they include have played a significant role in the development of data protection laws around the globe. Understanding the Fair Information Practice Principles and how they should be implemented is critical to comply with the various privacy laws that protect personal information.

We also agree to the Individual Redress Principle which requires that individuals have the right to legally pursue enforceable rights against data collectors and processors who fail to adhere to the law. This principle requires not only that individuals have enforceable rights against data users, but also that individuals have recourse to courts or government agencies to investigate and/or prosecute non-compliance by data processors.

CAN SPAM ACT

The CAN-SPAM Act is a law that sets the rules for commercial email, establishes requirements for commercial messages, gives recipients the right to have emails stopped from being sent to them, and spells out tough penalties for violations.

WE COLLECT YOUR EMAIL ADDRESS IN ORDER TO:

- Send information, respond to inquiries, and/or other requests or questions

TO BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH CANSPAM, WE AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING:
